

**Emory Decatur Hospital
School of Radiologic Technology
Program Effectiveness Data
2014-2018**

The Radiologic Technology program assesses its effectiveness by tracking the 5-year program completion rate, credentialing pass rate, and job placement rate. This data is compiled from program statistics, as well as feedback obtained via graduate and employer surveys. This data may also be found on the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology website @ www.jrcert.org.

Program Completion Rate- Program completion rate is defined as the number of students who complete the 24 month program within 150% of the published program length (within 36 months).

Benchmark: The program will maintain a five-year average program completion rate of 75 percent, with an attrition rate of 25 percent or less.

ARRT Credentialing Pass Rate

Benchmark: The program will maintain a five-year average credentialing exam pass rate on the (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists) of not less than 90 percent (at first attempt) within six months of graduation.

Job Placement Rate

Benchmark: The program will maintain a five-year average 100% job placement rate based on the percentage of graduates “actively seeking employment” within 12 months of graduation.

**JRCERT defines “not actively seeking employment” as:*

- 1) Graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts*
- 2) Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation*
- 3) Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours*
- 4) Graduate is on active military duty*
- 5) Graduate is continuing education.*
